



# JUNE LEADER'S GUIDE

**First Meeting in June:** JB2Bs will attend the Bethel's Opening Ceremony. Bees should be invited to participate in Circle of Prayer before the meeting begins. If the Bethel has a JB2B flag, one bee will present the flag during the opening ceremony.

After being excused from the Bethel Meeting, the Bees will go to their meeting space.


**Set Up:**

- Horn of Plenty Handout
- Pencils/Pencil Crayons
- Small waffle or sugar cones
- Packages of gummy fruit snacks

**Discussion of the Day:** What are you thankful for in your life?

Remind the Bees about previous activities and conversations you had where you learned about Job's first and second daughters. Ask the Bees if they remember what their names were (Jemima & Kezia)? Do the Bees remember what their names mean (dove and cassia, used in incense)?

Explain that Job had a third daughter named Keren Happuch. Her name meant "plenty", and we use the Horn of Plenty to remember her. Give the Bees the Keren Happuch handout. Read the information on it about Job's third daughter out loud to the Bees. Ask them if they have any questions about her.






**Activity of the Day:** Give the Bees the Horn of Plenty handout. Have the Bees complete the activity as listed on the paper. Give each Bee a small waffle or sugar cone and a package of gummy fruit snacks. They can then use these to create their own version of a Horn of Plenty.

**Meeting Wrap Up:** Ensure to have collected contact information from the families so that they can be invited to further events. If your Bethel meets during the day, you may choose to stay for the Bethel Closing Ceremony and social time.

Explain what a Bethel Installation is and why we hold this event every six months.


Suggested wording:


