
After being excused from the Bethel Meeting, the Bees will go to their meeting space.


Set Up: Applications for Membership

Discussion of the Day: If you could create an organization for girls, what would it be like? Job's Daughters was founded in Omaha, Nebraska by a woman named Ethel T. Wead Mick. Explain what Grand Session is.

Activity of the Day: Play the "Mother Mick Game". Show the Jobie to Bees the board with the images from the Mother Mick game on them. Have the Bees study the board for a few minutes before covering it up. Ask the Bees what images they remember seeing. As they describe an image, explain the information that has been provided about that image and how it relates to Mother Mick and Job's Daughters.

Meeting Wrap Up: Ensure to have collected contact information from the families so that they can be invited to further events. If your Bethel meets during the day, you may choose to stay for the Bethel Closing Ceremony and social time. Give each Jobie to Bee a copy of the Buds of Promise activity sheet to work on at home.



Discussion of the Day: How do you “give back” to your community? How can Job's Daughters help make the world a better place? Have you ever volunteered to help raise money for a charity?

Activity of the Day: Job's Daughters has our own charity that we support. It is called H.I.K.E. Fund Canada. HIKE stands for “Hearing Improvement Kids Equipment”, and the charity provides hearing or assistive listening devices to children in need. Jobies across Canada raise money to assist children under the age of 20, who have mild to severe hearing loss, whose families have a financial need. The aim is to help kids achieve a better quality of life. Applicants with documented hearing loss are considered.

Some of the devices that the H.I.K.E. Fund has provided are cochlear implant batteries, FM/DM systems and accessories, specialized alerting systems, specialized sports equipment and classroom sound field systems.





What kind of fundraiser could you plan to help support the H.I.K.E. Fund? Give the Jobie to Bees the Human Ear Colouring Sheet and go over the important parts of the ear. Talk about why protecting your hearing is important.
