

# MAY LEADER'S GUIDE

**First Meeting in May:** JB2Bs will attend the Bethel's Opening Ceremony. Bees should be invited to participate in the Circle of Prayer before the meeting begins. If the Bethel has a JB2B flag, one bee will present the flag during the opening ceremony.

**Game: This is Me!** This activity helps kids express who they are.


**How to Play:**

1. Grab a piece of paper and draw a picture of yourself.
2. Add things that represent your identity, like your favourite athlete or where you live.
3. Swap drawings with friends and discuss what's similar and different.

This game is a fun way to help kids feel comfortable in their own skin. It encourages them to share and learn about each other, which is essential for teamwork and leadership.

**Homework:** Ask your bees to pick something when they are at home that is important to them. They should bring this item with them to the next beehive meeting and then take turns explaining what the item is, and why it is important. The Beekeeper should do the same so that they can lead by example.
